Principal's Note – KCTC Students receive the MDE Breaking Traditions Award and Skutt Scholarship

Each year, in May, KCTC recognizes students for extraordinary achievement. This year at the annual "End of the Year Student Awards Ceremony" we recognized over 281 students. Included in that number were five students that earned either the Breaking Traditions Merit Award or the Robert H. Skutt Scholarship.

The Breaking Traditions Merit Award recognizes students who have demonstrated success in Career Tech Ed programs that are nontraditional to their gender. These students received their award at a ceremony at the Library of Michigan in Lansing. Both Arriya Harris, a senior in Criminal Justice who also attends East Kentwood High School and Damarias Sanchez a junior in Aviation Maintenance who also attends Potter's House High School earned this award.

The Robert H. Skutt Scholarship was awarded to three KCTC students. The Skutt Scholarship is awarded on a competitive basis to exemplary students completing programs at KCTC.
